

Dear Parents/Carers,

As you will no doubt be aware, the way that our school functions will be changing significantly from Monday onwards, and as such many of our children will be remaining at home for the foreseeable future. As a staff, we are keen to continue to support our children's learning as much as possible, and as such we have put in place the following arrangements and recommendations:

- Some year groups will be sending home packs of work which can be completed; these will be sent home from today. For any children who are currently absent, these can be collected from the school office;
- All children will have their reading books at home, and we recommend that they read for at least 15 minutes per day;
- All children have a 'TT Rockstars' account, and will benefit from accessing this daily for at least 15 minutes if possible (<https://www.ttrockstars.com/>);
- As a school, all of our children have access to a 'Purple Mash' account (<https://www.purplemash.com/login/>), through which activities and tasks will be set; please try to check this frequently, as staff will be updating it regularly.
